3. A briefing/training in Alpine equipment, as well as behaviour on the mountain
4. Availability (rental) of climbing harness/crampons/ski-, hiking stick
5. Voluntary participation in the Ecumenical worship service
6. Tickets for the Zermatt Mountain Railways on the day of mountain climbing
7. Participation in the solidary summit-striker lunch at the middle station
8. Diploma on the ascent of the 4163 meter high Breithorn summit
9. Organized hike to the middle station for all companions
10. Participation at the round-table and signature of the new edition of the Declaration of Zermatt 2018
11. Final dinner and Get2Gether

The participants must assume the following points themselves:

1. Costs for the journey to and from Zermatt and lodging
2. Catering outside the SPIRIT of SOLIDARITY event framework
3. Sufficient health insurance for foreign countries as well as an international accident insurance

Important information about the event SPIRIT of SOLIDARITY:

In the following section you will find important information for your trip to Zermatt and the preparation for the event.

1. The town of Zermatt is car-free. It is possible to arrive from the valley with the Swiss railway.
2. The town of Zermatt is located at 1608 meters above sea level.
3. With 4163 meters, the Breithorn is the easiest to climb four-thousender in the region.
4. Even in summer, temperatures below 0 ° Celsius/32 ° Fahrenheit can occur in the altitudes
5. The glacier Breithorn is covered with snow throughout the year.
6. The oxygen content in the air decreases from a height of 1500 meters on. The body slowly accustoms to the altitude (from 2 days on).
7. The sun's UV rays increase in high altitudes, sunburns are possible even at low temperatures.
8. A mountain climb is possible for every person. It is recommended to take a physical training/preparation before the trip.
9. In Switzerland, the franc is a means of payment. Generally, all major credit cards are accepted.

Participants should consider the following things before departure:

1. Clothing for all weather conditions
 - a. Mountain hiking boots suitable for mounting crampons!
 - b. Warm underwear
 - c. Cap & Gloves
 - d. Sturdy hiking or trekking trousers
 - e. Warm Outerwear
 - f. Rain Jacket
2. Sun glasses
3. Sun protection
4. Travel health and accident insurance

In order to ensure the appearance of the participants, the organiser reserves the right to request a deposit of Euro 90.00 from the participant. The deposit is due only from the date of the participant's admission to the event by the organizer. The deposit will be returned during the accreditation process in Zermatt.

Conditions of Participation

The following Conditions of Participation apply to participation in the project SPIRIT of SOLIDARITY (hereinafter referred to as "the project"). The organiser ("organiser" or "we") is Ute Louis Beteiligungs- & Vermögensverwaltungs GmbH & Co KG, St. Benedict Str. 23, 20149 Hamburg.

The project relates to the collective ascent by 100 persons affected by breast cancer to the summit of the Breithorn, a mountain near Zermatt, Switzerland. The event will take place on a single day in September 2018.

I. Participation

1. Any legally competent natural person who is, or who has been, diagnosed with breast cancer is entitled to participate.
2. The application for participation is made by filling in the application form and submitting it to the organiser. Participants are selected by the organiser on the basis of various criteria, such as degree to which one is personally affected and athletic experience. The organiser is free to select the participants. We are entitled to request further information and documents from applicants and participants, which we need for the proper implementation of the project. This applies in particular to information concerning, for example, the participant's accommodation and requirements for the selection of the equipment provided by us. In this case, the participant must provide us with the necessary information and documents within a reasonable period of time notified by us.
3. Only one application per natural person is permitted at a time. There is no legal entitlement to be selected for or participate in the project. Legal recourse is excluded.
4. The participants will be notified by mail and email.
5. Participants must provide only accurate information in the application form and when answering our questions. We have the right to exclude the respective applicant if incorrect information is provided, if required information or documents are not provided in time, or if there are any other infringements of the Conditions of Participation. This also applies if the applicant has already been selected for participation. In this case, another candidate will be selected for participation instead of the excluded applicant.
6. We treat all information submitted to us by applicants with the utmost confidentiality and respect. The applicant's data will be deleted immediately after selection of the participants (including any successors), in accordance with data protection regulations, as long as they are not still needed for the implementation of the project. Information provided will only be used for the implementation of the project and in accordance with legal regulations. It will not be used for any other purposes. Further information on the project's privacy policy can be found at www.spirit-of-solidarity.com.
7. The project communication usually takes place by e-mail. Participants must therefore ensure that they receive our e-mails and are able to take note of them within a reasonable period of time.
8. Participation is free of charge. Participants are, however, responsible for the costs of participation such as travel expenses, accommodation and equipment, unless provided by us. We will provide the participants on site with climbing harness, crampons, combined ski and hiking stick. Further information on the project can be found on the Internet at www.spirit-of-solidarity.com.

II. Application deposit

The prerequisite for participation is the payment of a deposit, which will be refunded upon accreditation of the participant. The application deposit is Euro 90.00 (ninety). The deposit must only be paid by those applicants who have been selected for participation. The organiser undertakes to reimburse the deposit if the participant arrives on site to participate in the project and is accredited for this purpose. The deposit will also be refunded if the participant

- a) cancels her participation before 1 August 2018, without the need for a reason, or
- b) is prevented from participating for reasons for which she bears no responsibility, and which can be proven by the participant.

If the participant fails to appear or fails to accredit herself, for reasons that she is responsible for, the deposit will be forfeited and the amount will be used to finance the project. The participant must pay the deposit by bank transfer. Applicants who have been selected for participation and do not pay the deposit within 30 days after receiving a corresponding invoice will be excluded from participation. Statutory rights of withdrawal or revocation remain unaffected.

III. Implementation

1. The selected participants will receive the final date of project implementation and expected schedule via email by 31 May 2018 at the latest. Participants must then ensure that they can participate in the project in accordance with the schedule.
2. We can, without being obliged to do so, offer a supporting programme for one adult person accompanying the participant. The accompanying person is registered after the selection of the participants. Arrival, departure, accommodation and catering of the accompanying person is the responsibility of the respective participant.
3. We are entitled to postpone the project, change the schedule or cancel the project altogether, if compelling circumstances, for which we are not responsible, make this inevitable. This applies in particular, for example, if a safe implementation of the project is not possible due to weather conditions. In this case the participant is not entitled to reimbursement of expenses. We endeavour to organise any changes and postponements in consultation with the participants, in such a way that additional efforts and expenses are kept as low as possible.

IV. Requirements

1. All participants acknowledge that mountaineering tours in the alpine area entail mountain-specific hazards and effects, in particular due to weather and terrain conditions. We cannot rule out the resulting risks and restrictions on comfort. Participants must bring and use appropriate mountain equipment (shoes, clothing, sunglasses, sun protection etc.), unless provided by us.
2. The consumption of alcoholic beverages, drugs or other mind-altering substances in a temporal context, which has an influence on the participant or her behaviour during the project (before or during the project) is prohibited.

3. We try to ensure as safe an implementation of the project as possible by providing medical care on site as well as the provision of knowledgeable mountain guides. Nevertheless, the participant must ensure that he or she is able to participate in the project. This particularly concerns the state of health required for climbing the mountain. The height of the Breithorn is approx. 4,150 metres. The participants have to take into account the associated demands on fitness, alpine mobility and training and have to meet these demands. Participants must also have the necessary prior knowledge about alpine conditions. A risk to the participant cannot be ruled if this prior knowledge is lacking. We are entitled to exclude participants from participation if the medical staff on site advises against participation or if the participant refuses to participate in the examination of his or her eligibility for participation. The examination of eligibility for participation is carried out for the protection of the participants. However, there is no liability on our part if a lack of eligibility for participation is not detected.

4. All participants must provide and prove, for the entire duration of the project, the existence of a health insurance policy with unlimited coverage in Switzerland as well as a repatriation abroad in case of injury or illness.

5. Participants must ensure that, with the exception of breast cancer, [diagnosed, in treatment or completed treatment], there are no sources of risk (excluding pre-existing conditions or conditions which endanger the participant, in particular cardiovascular diseases, damage to the skeletal, muscular or musculoskeletal system, infections, particular sensitivities, injuries, psychological disorders, etc.). In case of doubt, the participant must inform us about potential problems and risks prior to the project. **We are entitled to ask participants - also in writing, if necessary - for truthful notification of such risks and to exclude participants who refuse to answer from participation. In case of incorrect or incomplete notification of risks by the applicant, our liability for resulting damages is excluded.**

6. The instructions of the mountain guides and leaders on site must be followed. Our liability is excluded if the participant fails to comply with the instructions. The participant must draw the attention of the attendant staff present on the spot to any instructions which are misleading, ambiguous or which, in the participant's assessment, entail a risk for the participant.

V. Liability

1. The organiser shall be liable exclusively for culpable breach of essential contractual obligations ("cardinal obligations"; such obligations, the fulfilment of which are indispensable for the achievement of the contractual purpose), any guarantees assumed by the organiser and for injury to life, limb or health. In all other respects, the organiser is liable only for intent and gross negligence. Insofar as the liability of the organiser is excluded or limited, this shall also apply to the benefit of its legal representatives, employees and assistants, as well as to claims for reimbursement of expenses.

2. Insofar as the liability of the organiser is not mandatory in accordance with the above provisions in paragraph 1, the liability of the organiser is excluded and participation in the project is at the participant's own risk.

VI. Termination of participation

1. Every participant is entitled to withdraw from her participation by a declaration to the organiser. Any investments in the participation made by the participant herself up to this point, such as room bookings, shall be borne by the participant. In this case, the deposit shall be refunded, subject to paragraph 2 below. Participants are advised to take out travel cancellation insurance for the outward and return journeys, which they have to organise themselves.

2. In the event of a cancellation after 1 August 2018 the deposit will be forfeited and will be used to finance the project, unless there is an important reason such as illness or other obstacles for which the participant is not responsible.

VII. Miscellaneous

1. The text of the contract will be saved by us and made available to the applicant upon request.
2. In principle, we are neither willing nor obliged to participate in dispute settlement proceedings before a consumer arbitration board.
3. The contract shall be governed by the law of the Federal Republic of Germany to the exclusion of the UN Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods. This choice of law will only apply to consumers insofar as the consumer is not deprived of the protection afforded to him by mandatory provisions of the law of the state of the consumer's habitual residence.
4. Insofar as participants do not have a general place of jurisdiction within the Federal Republic of Germany, the place of jurisdiction for all disputes arising from the contractual relationship between the participant and us shall be Hamburg.
5. The ineffectiveness of individual provisions of these Terms and Conditions of Participation shall not affect the effectiveness of their remaining provisions. The ineffective provisions shall be replaced by statutory provisions, if applicable. Insofar as this would represent an unreasonable hardship for one of the contracting parties, however, the contract as a whole shall become ineffective.
